3. Background/Outline

The goal 3 of the SDGs (Sustainable Development Goals) aims to “ensure healthy lives and promote wellbeing for all at all ages”. Especially, achieving UHC is prioritized as the target 3.8 under the goal 3 and is regarded an overarching issue. This will require political commitment for assuring the health system for delivering quality health care in timely and financially affordable manner. Development of human resource who is the core of quality care as well as enhancement of research capacity are also necessary towards achieving target 3.8. Development of health workforce who is the core of quality care as well as enhancement of research capacity is also essential.

To this end, human development in the field related to UHC is a strategic area of cooperation between developing countries and Japan, taking advantage of wide knowledge/technologies accumulated in Japan's universities.

Considering the resource of Japan's universities and specific needs of regional as well as country level, following three are will highlighted:

- Health Policy (Public Health)
- NCDs/Ageing
- Disaster and Radiation Medical Sciences
- Health Workforce Development

4. Objectives**(1) Overall Goal**

- Develop human resources in the field related to attaining UHC
- Strengthen a human network between developing countries and Japan in the field related to attaining UHC.

Master's Program

Admission Policy

The purpose of this program is to further develop skills that can help support people's health at all levels by acquiring the ability to develop nursing science in a practical and creative manner. Furthermore, this program aims to advance deep understanding for the dignity of life and human existence by utilizing advanced practical abilities to respond to changes in the health, medical, and welfare environments as well as education and research capabilities in the field of nursing.

Desired student profile:

- 1) A well-rounded character with the academic ability, and a clear desire to study or research at a graduate school.
- 2) Active in clinical or educational fields of health, medical care, and welfare with an ambition to improve as a nursing professional.
- 3) A strong interest in nursing science or nursing practice and an eagerness to actively engage in academic activities after entering school.
- 4) A willingness to contribute to society as a skilled nursing practitioner, nursing educator, or nursing researcher.

Curriculum Policy

For the Master's Program, a Special Research Course and a Certified Nurse Specialist Course* have been established to further develop nursing practitioners, nursing educators, and nursing researchers. In the Special Research Course, the curriculum is designed to explore the theory of nursing science and the research ability necessary to build this theory, and in the Certified Nurse Specialist Course, the curriculum is designed to explore the advanced practical ability and research ability in the field of practice. The results of research and study are evaluated comprehensively based on evaluation criteria that are specified in advance. The outcomes of these evaluations will be used to facilitate improvements to our approach to education.

- 1) Common Subjects
In both the Special Research Course and the Certified Nurse Specialist Course, courses are offered in which students acquire a wide range of knowledge that will serve as the foundation for research methods, ethics, and learning.
- 2) Specialized Subjects
The necessary subjects will be provided to train advanced nursing practitioners, nursing educators, and nursing researchers in each specialized field.
- 3) Practice and Research Guidance
In the Special Research Course, specialized research is conducted, and in the Certified Nurse Specialist Course, issue-based research is conducted. Practice guidance is given to identify specific issues, students acquire advanced specialized research methods, and a master's thesis is required in order to encourage students to develop the ability to logically summarize academic results.

* Certified Nurse Specialist Course is unavailable for Global Nursing Course students.

Diploma Policy

The degree (Master's in Nursing), will be granted to those who have been enrolled in the standard term of study (2 years), have acquired the credits required for completion, have acquired the following qualifications and abilities, and have passed the review and final examination of their master's thesis or thesis research project.

- 1) The ability to engage in specialized research in nursing fields with high ethical standards.
- 2) The ability to systematize the extensive knowledge necessary to demonstrate a high level of expertise and practice high quality nursing care.
- 3) The ability to contribute to society and the world through advanced nursing practice, research, and educational activities.

3 Application Requirements

Candidates applying for the master's program for 2022 will require a recommendation from the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA).

Eligible applicants to whom any the following (1) through (9) apply:

- (1) Applicants who have graduated from a course in nursing or health science at a university in Japan or are expected to graduate by the time of admission.
- (2) Applicants who have been granted a bachelor's degree (in nursing or health science) by the National Institution for Academic Degrees and Quality Enhancement of Higher Education pursuant to the provisions of Article 104, Clause 7 of the School Education Act, or applicants who are expected to be granted a bachelor's degree (in nursing or health science) by the institution by the time of admission.
- (3) A person who has completed or is expected to complete 16 years of schooling (with the last course taken being either nursing or health science) in a foreign country by the time of admission.
*1 Applicants must confirm they meet the preliminary confirmation of eligibility
- (4) Applicants who have completed or are expected to complete 16 years of schooling (with the last course taken being either nursing or health science) by a distance learning course administered by a school outside of Japan, while living in Japan by the time of admission.
- (5) Applicants who have graduated from an educational institution (restricted to graduates of nursing or health care science) in Japan that is recognized by a country outside of Japan as corresponding to the university curriculum in that country's educational system (restricted to curriculum whose graduates are considered to have completed 16 years of school education in that country), and which has been approved by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (Locations in Japan of a Foreign University designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology), or applicants who are expected to have completed such a course by the time of admission.
- (6) Applicants who have obtained a degree equivalent to a bachelor's degree (in nursing or health care science) by graduating from an academic program at least 3 years in length^{a)} at a school or university outside of Japan^{b)}, or applicants that are expected to have obtained such a degree by the time of admission.

*1 Applicants must confirm they meet the preliminary confirmation of eligibility

- a) Applicants who have graduated from a distance learning course administered by a school outside of Japan while living in Japan or from an international school in Japan, whose curriculum corresponds to a country outside of Japan and has been approved as per the previous item (Locations in Japan of a Foreign University designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology) are also qualified to apply.

- b) Applicants must have graduated from an institution certified by a government or accreditation institution outside of Japan that reviews academic and research activities, or that has been approved by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology.
- (7) Applicants who have completed, or are expected to complete by the time of admission, a specialized course of study at an advanced vocational school (limited to those satisfying the requirement that the term of study is four years or more and other standards specified by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology) designated separately by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (List of Training Institutes Designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology) on or after the day designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology.
- (8) Applicants who have completed a course in nursing science or a course in health care science at a former education school, etc. (1953 Ministry of Education Notification No. 5, Nos. 1 to 4, 1955 Ministry of Education Notification No. 39, No. 1).
- *1 Applicants must confirm they meet the preliminary confirmation of eligibility**
- (9) Applicants who are recognized by this graduate school through individual screening of eligibility for admission as having scholastic ability equivalent to or higher than that of university graduates and who will be 22 years of age by the time of admission (applicants who do not fall under (1) to (8) above but hold a license for either Public Health Nurse, Midwife, or Nurse, and has professional experience of engaging in work that requires such licenses for 3 years or more at the time of application [selection of working adults], etc.).

◎ In accordance with Juntendo University Graduate School Enrollment Scholarship Benefit Rules, alumni of Juntendo University, or Juntendo Medical College of Nursing, Juntendo Nursing College, etc., and applicants who work at the University (full-time employees at the time of enrollment procedures) will submit a scholarship benefit application form upon enrollment, and half of the enrollment fee will be paid as a scholarship for selected candidates. In addition, self-funded international students may be exempted from part of their tuition fees based on the Juntendo University International Student Scholarship Benefits Regulations.

◎ In principle, payments already made will not be refunded. 11 Notes

- (1) After the application has been received, the entrance examination fee will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- (2) If applicants who are expected to graduate fail to graduate, their admission will be revoked even if they have been accepted.

Security Export Control (for non-Japanese examinees)

In accordance with the Foreign Exchange and Foreign Trade Act, which seeks to protect both national and international peace and security, Juntendo University has established the Juntendo University Security Export Control Regulations to preserve academic and research activities. International students accepted into the graduate school program should consult with their supervising professor about their research prior to submitting the application because there are cases where students must modify their application due to the research.

International students accepted into the graduate school program must sign a pledge indicating they will comply with the Foreign Exchange and Foreign Trade Act at the time of their enrollment.

12 Degree Conferred

Persons who have acquired the designated credits from the Graduate School of Health Care and Nursing (Master's Program) at this Graduate School, and who have passed the review of their thesis and the final examination will be awarded a master's degree (in nursing).

14 Completion Requirements

The requirements for completion at the Graduate School of Health Care and Nursing (Master's Program) are as follows: a student enrolled in the course for at least 2 years; acquired a total of at least 30 credits consisting of at least 8 credits from common subjects, including 4 credits from compulsory subjects; at least 10 credits from specialized subjects; and at least 8 credits from practice and research guidance, including 4 credits from compulsory subjects; and submitting a master's thesis or research thesis upon having received the required research supervision, and pass the review and final examination. Please receive guidance from your research advisor in advance when choosing subjects. The enrollment period may be shortened for those who have achieved excellent research results and have been enrolled for at least one year.

Admission Policy

The purpose of this program is to further develop skills that can help support the people's health at all levels by acquiring the ability to develop nursing science in a practical and creative manner. Furthermore, this program aims to develop talent with a rich academic knowledge, that can independently advance academic research in the field of nursing, contribute to a better medical environment and the maintenance and improvement of health, and who is capable of thriving on the global stage.

Desired student profile:

- 1) A well-rounded personality who is inquisitive and willing to pursue research independently from the perspective of nursing science.
- 2) A strong intellectual interest in the field of nursing and a desire to pursue world-class research.
- 3) A desire to contribute to the development of nursing science and the improvement in the quality of nursing care as an advanced nursing practitioner, nursing science educator, or nursing science researcher by utilizing the advanced education and research abilities acquired.

Curriculum Policy

The Doctoral Course consists of common subjects, specialized subjects, and practice and research guidance with the aim of cultivating research abilities to pioneer new fields, such as nursing support for individuals, their families supporting them, and people living in the community. Further aims are the development of educational support for nurses and the establishment of nursing provision systems. The results of research and study are evaluated comprehensively based on the evaluation criteria that are specified in advance. The outcomes of these evaluations will be used to facilitate improvements to our approach to education.

- 1) Common Subjects
The purpose of these subjects is to link high quality research results based on the ability to explore the essence of nursing science with high ethical standards and a sense of responsibility.
- 2) Specialized Subjects
The purpose of these courses is to enable students to conduct practical research on a wide range of health and nursing issues. Students acquire more advanced research skills, such as verifying knowledge and technologies in nursing science and establishing new theories and methodologies. They learn about nursing issues and research approaches related to their own research themes from a multidisciplinary perspective and cultivate an academic foundation. Based on the 12 fields of the Master's Program (MS), 12 subjects will be established with the aim of instilling advanced specialized knowledge and academic perspectives on nursing support development, management systems, and educational support for individuals, the families who support them, and people living in the community.
- 3) Practice and Research Guidance
Nursing Practice and Nursing Special Research were established with the aim of acquiring research abilities that will sharpen and deepen the research necessary for instructors, researchers, and managers who are capable of carrying out educational and research activities at nursing universities and research institutions in Japan and overseas, as well as highly specialized professionals who have scientific perspectives in health, medical, and welfare fields and can exercise their educational and research abilities.

Diploma Policy

A degree (Doctorate in Nursing) will be granted to those who have been enrolled in the standard term of study (3 years), have acquired the credits required for completion, have acquired the following qualifications and abilities, and have passed the review and final examination of their doctoral thesis.

- 1) The ability to research and develop new theories and nursing care based on high-level academic knowledge, advanced specialized knowledge, and practical ability
- 2) The ability to contribute to academic exchange and health care activities on an interdisciplinary and international basis as a leader, manager, educator, or researcher with outstanding expertise, ethics, and a sense of responsibility.

Candidates applying for the doctoral program for 2022 will require a recommendation from the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA).

Eligible applicants to whom any the following (1) through (7) apply:

- (1) Applicants who have been awarded or are expected to be awarded by the time of enrollment, a master's degree or professional degree.
- (2) Applicants who have been awarded or are expected to be awarded by the time of enrollment, a master's degree or a degree equivalent to a professional degree from a foreign country.
*1 Applicants must confirm they meet the preliminary confirmation of eligibility.
- (3) Applicants who have been awarded or are expected to be awarded by the time of enrollment, a master's degree or a degree equivalent to a professional degree via distance learning course administered by a school outside of Japan, while living in Japan.
- (4) A person who has completed a course of study at a non-Japanese school designated in Japan as equivalent to a non-Japanese graduate school (Locations in Japan of a Foreign University [graduate school equivalent] designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology) and has been awarded, or is expected to be awarded by the time of enrollment, a degree equivalent to a master's degree or a professional degree.
- (5) Applicants who have completed the course of United Nations University and have been awarded or are expected to be awarded by the time of enrollment, a degree equivalent to a master's degree.
- (6) Applicants who have been approved by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (Ministry of Education Notification No. 118 of September 1, 1989).
*2 Preliminary eligibility review required.
 - ① Applicants who have graduated from a university and has engaged in research at a university, research institute, etc., for two years or longer, and who is recognized by the Graduate School as having academic ability equivalent to or higher than that of a person who holds a master's degree based on the results of said research, etc.
 - ② Applicants who have been engaged in research at a university, research institute, etc., for 2 years or more after completing 16 years of school education in a foreign country or after completing 16 years of school education in a foreign country via distance learning course taken while living in Japan, and who are recognized by the Graduate School to have the scholastic ability equivalent to or higher than that of a person who has a master's degree based on the outcome of said research, etc.
- (7) Applicants whom the Graduate School has recognized through separate preliminary eligibility review as possessing the equivalent or greater academic ability than a person with a master's degree or professional degree and who have reached the age of 24 years by the time of enrollment.
